





This program will focus on sanitation in the Effia constituency:

An annual cleanup campaign dubbed "CLEANUP-EFFIA" lunched on the 1st of May,2024 will continue.

The exercise will include the following:

- 1.Desilting of all the drains in Effia during the rainy season.
- 2. Free refuse collection during the rainy season to prevent drains from becoming choked and causing floods.
- 3. Facilitate the construction of storm drains to control the flood crisis in Effia.

BUILDING OFFORTUNITIES FOR SUSTAINABLE SOLUTIONS

BOSS DAAKYEPA EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM policy seeks to improve access to education, reduce financial burdens on parents, and enhance the quality of teaching and learning in Effia schools. This initiative will be funded by \*DACF and other bilateral institutions\*

### **BENEFITS**

- 1. Free mattresses for newly admitted boarding students from Effia.
- 2. Subsidized exercise books for basic school students in Effia every academic year.
- 3. Construction of an ultra-modern ICT and library center in Effia.
- 4. Revamping existing ICT laboratories in various schools to standards.
- 5. Eradication of chalkboards to marker boards in all the basic schools in Effia.
- 6. Special support for girls in technical and vocational training



Arrangements will be made with the metro mass transport system to provide a shuttle with a moderate fare to convey students from Effiakuma and other distant areas to campus. This initiative will help students save money on transportation for lectures.

### From Source to Tap Project

This project will focus on delivering clean and safe water to the student community of Takoradi Technical University (TTU). We will concentrate on storage and easy accessibility. It will be a major initiative to solve the water problems faced by the student community.

## BOSS DREAM ACHIEVERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

There will be a merit-based scholarship program for brilliant but needy students from Effia in TTU. Also, there's going to be a tailor-made scholarship program from the office of the Member of Parliament to support serious but needy students in Effia and TTU at large.

This program will be on the recommendation of the deans of the various schools.

Ten beneficiaries will be selected on each category, totaling twenty students' beneficiaries every academic year.
